Cabot® Composite Cleaner

Composition:

CAUTION: CONTAINS CALCIUM HYPOCHLORITE

Restrictions:

Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Use only in areas with adequate ventilation. When mixing with water, avoid breathing powder. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wear protective goggles, gloves, shoes and other appropriate clothing. **NEVER MIX OR USE WITH OTHER CHEMICALS, DETERGENTS, CLEANERS OR WITH CABOT® PROBLEM-SOLVER® WOOD BRIGHTENER. TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN THE RAPID RELEASE OF HAZARDOUS GASES. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS.**

Environmental Impact:

This product is biodegradable. Protect any nearby plants, shrubs or other vegetation by wetting them down with water and covering them with plastic before application. Hose off shrubs when job is done.

Clean-up:

Rinse out container and application equipment thoroughly with water. Do not re-use container.

Surface Preparation:

FOR EXTERIOR USE ONLY.

USE ON: COMPOSITE DECKS, RAILINGS, STEPS AND MOST SYNTHETIC SURFACES INCLUDING VINYL FENCES AND CLADDING.

How to Mix:

Mix one cup of powder per one gallon of water in a clean plastic bucket. Stir gently until all powder is completely dissolved. Mix only the amount necessary to complete the project. Do not store mixed cleaner. For each litre mixed, approximately 7.4 square metres of decking, fencing or cladding can be cleaned, depending on the porosity of the surface. Total package contents will make 19 litres of cleaning solution, enough to clean approximately 140 square metres.

How to Use:

APPLY LIBERALLY to dirty surfaces using a scrubbing brush or pump type sprayer. Protect eyes and skin with appropriate protective equipment. Apply only when air and surface temperatures are 50-90°F (10-32°C). Do not apply to hot surfaces. To avoid non-uniform appearances on fencing, start at the bottom,

working a small section at a time. Continue to the top of the fence, and be sure to cover the surface thoroughly.

LET SET 15-20 MINUTES. Stubborn areas may require scrubbing with a stiff bristle brush. If surface begins to dry quickly, apply more cleaning solution or lightly mist with water.

RINSE OFF CLEANER AND CONTAMINANTS using a garden hose with nozzle at maximum pressure. Repeat procedure if necessary. Allow cleaned surfaces to dry completely before staining or painting.

IMPORTANT BEFORE AND AFTER STEPS

TEST IT...on a small, hidden area at recommended dilution to determine its effectiveness.

PROTECT SHRUBS...wet down with water and cover. Hose off shrubs when job is done.

PROTECT GLASS...wet down with water or cover with plastic. Hose off glass frequently to prevent streaking.

CLEAN-UP...rinse equipment and overspray areas thoroughly with water. Rinse out container, do not reuse.

Precautions:

NOTE: Cabot Composite Cleaner is not a paint or stain remover. It will, however, remove paint or stain on an unsound surface.

IMPORTANT: When applying and rinsing cleaner, walking surfaces, ladders and scaffolding may become slippery. Rinse all such surfaces thoroughly to remove overspray.

Storage:

Keep powder in tightly sealed container. Store in a cool, dry place at temperatures between 50- 100°F (10-38°C).
